

Dear Parents and Carers,

This term is going to be a busy one, with lots of fun and exciting whole school events. We have listed all the dates from now until Christmas. Please note, that class assemblies and class masses are not listed. You are always welcome to attend when it's your child's mass /assembly.

September:

<u>Whole School Mass:</u> Thursday 13^{th} September - we will commence our new school year with a Mass at Our Lady of Sorrows at 9:30am. Parents and Carers are welcome to attend.

<u>Roald Dahl Day</u>: Thursday 13th September - we will spend the day celebrating the great children's author Roald Dahl. Your child is invited to come to school dressed as their favourite Roald Dahl character.

<u>Meet the teaching team evening</u>: Week commencing 17th September starting at 3:45pm. This is a vital opportunity for you to meet the teaching team, see the classroom and agree of the expectations of the year.
